

Program of Pharmaceutical Sciences (BPHS)

The **study plan** of Bachelor of Pharmaceutical Sciences, is 174 credit hours (5 year program), consists of: 1 common year + 4 entry level professional years.

During the following four professional years, the students will be focusing firmly on medicines and patients, understanding the development and design of drugs and gaining a wide range of skills and intellectual experience in core pharmacy science subjects. They, also acquire the flexibility to shape his/her degree to career aspirations whether as a pharmacist in healthcare or industry, researcher, educator, etc..

In conjunction, students are required to complete two training courses (Summer Pharmacy Training, PHTR 411 and PHTR 412) following the 8th and 10th levels.

Students must complete a research project as a requirement for their graduation (PHTR 495).

A research day, supported by the college and Deanship of research, is held at the end of the academic year, where students present their research projects as Poster presentations.
